

Southampton and on the north side of the three creeks containing
 by estimation five hundred and forty seven ^{and some half} acres be the same
 more or less and is bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning at
 a pine on the little plowman swamp, thence down the said swamp sixty
 four pole to a gum in the mouth of a small branch thence up the
 run of said branch one hundred and nineteen pole to a pine stump
 thence along Rivers Pass line four degrees west fifty eight pole to a hickory
 at Rawlings Road thence along the said road north eight degrees east fifty
 six pole thence north eighty five degrees east fifty six pole thence north
 eighty two degrees east forty nine pole to a hickory a Thomas Applewhite mill
 a corner of his land thence along his line south twenty four degrees east
 eleven pole to a hickory thence north fifty degrees east eighteen pole to
 a sweet gum at the run of the great plowman swamp thence down
 the run of said swamp one hundred and thirteen pole to a poplar a
 corner of said Thomas Applewhite's land thence along his line south
 seventy degrees west nine one pole to an oak at the run of the three
 creeks thence up the run of said creek three hundred and twelve pole
 to chestnut oak a corner of Elizabeth Lewis line thence along the said
 Lewis line two hundred and ninety two pole to the Beginning
 it being all the land purchased by the said Miles Bay of Elizabeth
 Bay, Roger Ann and Robert's Pass which will appear by their
 deed and survey made in the county of Southampton with all
 lands, tenements, her commons, profits, commodities, hereditaments,
 ways, waters, and appurtenances whatsoever to the said tract or
 parcel of land and premises belonging or in any wise appur-
 taining and ^{also} the reversion and reversions remainder remain-
 der and profits of the said premises and every part thereof
 of and all the estate, right, title interest property claim
 and demands whatsoever of them the said Miles Bay and
 Elizabeth his wife of us and to the said tract of land and
 premises and every part thereof to have and to hold the said
 tract or parcel of land and premises and every part or parcel
 thereof with the appurtenances unto him the said John Pass his
 heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of him the
