This Instrument made this second day of February one thousand seven hundred and Ninety nine Between Thomas Turner
Patience his wife of the county of Halifax and state of North
Carolina of the one part and Sterling Francis of the county
of Southampton and state of Virginia of the other part
Witnesseth that the said Thomas Turner and Patience his
wife for and in consideration of the sum of thirty Five
Pounds Current Money of Virginia, in hand paid by the
said Sterling Francis the receipt whereof is hereby ac-
knowledged hath granted, Bargained, sold, Released, &
Confirmed, and do by these presents, grant, Bargain,
Sell, Release, and confirm, unto the said Sterling Francis
his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel
of land containing Eighty Five acres more or less lying in
the aforesaid county of Southampton on the south of the flat swamp
being a part of a tract of land formerly held by Job Morgan
deed and bounded as follows, Beginning at a dead
pine in the flat swamp thence along Shadrach Newtons
line a west course to a corner pine thence along said Newtons
and Henry Smiths line to a corner a sweet gum in a
line of trees down the run of the said branch to the flat
swamp aforesaid thence down the flat swamp to the
beginning to have and to hold the said tract or parcel
land with the appurtenances thereto belonging unto the
said Sterling Francis his heirs and assigns forever together
with all and singular the advantages hereditam
and also the invasions and reversions, Remainder, and
Remainders, rents, issues & profits of the said land and
premises and also all the estates, right title claim and demands
of the said Thomas Turner and Patience his wife their heirs
executors, administrators or assigns of and to the said
land and premises before mentioned and of every part
thereof to the only proper use and and behoof of the
said
