hath bargained sold and confirmed and by these presents doth bargain sell
Allein enpoff and deliver unto the said Lazarus Cook his heirs Executors
or administrators one certain tract or parcell of Land lying and being in
The county of Southampton and on the East side of Little Swamp Cont-
aining by Estimation Two Hundred Acres be the same more or less and
bound as follows: Beginning at a gum in the said swamp thence nearly
East course a long a line of Marked trees to the head of the rushings swamp
thence down the various Courses of the said swamp to a red oak then
along a line of Marked trees to a white oak in middle Canray Pond thence
along a line of marked trees nearly a west course to a pine a corner tree
thence by a line of marked trees to the little swamp to a cypressa
corner tree thence up the various of the said swamp to the beginning to
have and to holde the said Land & premises with all the appurtenances
thereunto belonging unto the said Lazarus Cook and to his heirs forever
& the said Micajah Edwards & his wife Elizabeth doth for themselves
their heirs & forever Warrant and defend the title of the said Land against
all and every person or persons whatsoever lawfully claiming the
