for divers good causes and valuable considerations mi-
herunto moving have given granted and by these
presents do give grant and confirm unto my son Rich^d
Blunt all and singular my money & Goods which are
now in mercantile business in whose hands custody
possession or keeping the same are can or may be
found. To have and to hold all and singular the Lands
Money and goods whatsoever of me the said Jⁿ. Blunt
unto the said Richard Blunt his heirs and assigns
from henceforth to his and their own proper use
and therewith to do order and dispose at his or
their wills and pleasure as of their own money
and Goods freely and peaceably and quietly without any
manner of trouble or denial of me the said John Blunt or
any other person whatsoever of all which money and goods
I the said John Blunt have put the said Richard Blunt
in full peaceable and quiet possession by virtue hereof
In Witnes whereof I the said John Blunt have herunto
set my hand and Seal this 21st day of February Anno Domini 1799
