This Indenture made this Eighth day of Nov^r Anno¹⁷⁹⁸
one thousand seven hundred & Ninety Eight. Between William
Newsum & Tabitha Newsum of the one part & John Maglamie jr of
the other part Witnesseth that we the s^d William Newsum & Tabitha
Newsum for and in the consideration of the sum of one hundred and
fifty pounds £150 money of Virginia to us in hand paid the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained & sold Alienors &
confirm^d & by these presents doth bargain sell & deliver & confirm
unto the s^d John Maglamie jr his heirs & assigns forever one certain
Tract or parcel of Land lying & being in the County of Southampton
State of Virginia containing by Estimation one hundred & seventy
five acres be the same more or less & is bounded (as to wit) Beginning
at a Gum & corner tree dividing between the s^d Newsum & Myrick
from thence along a line of marked trees to a corner tree dividing
between the s^d Newsum, Myrick & Samuel Barham from thence by
a line of marked trees dividing between the s^d Newsum & Barham
to the ready branch from thence down the Clarines cascades of the run
of the s^d branch to a live Oak on the road dividing between the s^d
Newsum & Moses Foster from thence along the s^d Road to small and
& black Oak Dividing between the s^d Newsum & the aforesaid
Myrick from thence by a line of marked trees to the beginning
To have & to hold the said granted Premises together with all the
appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise therewith apper-
taining & the reversion & reversions & remainders thereof
to have & to hold the said Tract or parcel of Land & premises with these
& every of these appurtenances unto the said John Maglamie jr
