 September in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred
 Ninety Eight, between John Lee & Elizabeth Lee his wife of Southamp^{ton}
 of the County of Southampton of the One part and Jacob Darden jun^r of the
 County of Southampton of the Other part Witnesseth that the said John Lee
 & Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Seventy two
 pounds seven shillings & 9^d to them in hand paid by the said Jacob
 Darden jun^r before the executing & Delivery of these presents, the receipt
 whereof they do hereby acknowledge & themselves to be bounden fully
 satisfied contented & paid, have granted bargained & sold, they have
 do grant, bargain, sell, alien & confirm unto him the said Jacob Darden jun^r
 his Heirs & assigns forever a certain Tract or parcel of Land lying in
 the said County of Southampton, situate on the East side the bottom
 Swamp & West side of Black water river, bounded as followeth: Viz^t
 beginning at a Juniper a corner tree standing in the side of the Coar
 Swamp in said Dardens own lines thence lining on his own land
 to a Pine on the side of Black water River thence up the River
 to a small White Oak on the River bank (a corner tree) thence
 Westwardly along a line of marked trees to a corner pine standing on
