This Indenture made on the 13th day of Feb^r in the Year of Christ one Thousand seven hundred and ninety nine between Samuel Francis of the County of Southampton of the one part and William Pope of the said County of the other part that whereas William Francis of said County lately deceased died seized and possessed of a considerable real & personal Estate which the said Samuel Francis and William Pope are entitled and as they the said Samuel Francis and William Pope are willing that the Estate of the said William Francis should be divided between them the said Samuel Francis & William Pope without recurrence to a decree of any Court of Law now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Samuel Francis in consideration of the sum of five Milleings in hand paid current money of Virginia the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and in consideration of the aforementioned premises have bargained sold relinquished and ever quit claims and by these presents do bargain sell relinquish and ever quit claims unto the said William Pope and his Heirs all the right title and Interest to the following Slaves of which the said William Francis possessed to wit Lucy, Charlotte, Thann, Dany, Chaney, Sam, Sips, Vlany, Will. To have & to hold the said with their Heirs & Successors to him the said William Pope and his Heirs forever and the said Samuel Francis his Heirs Successors and Administrators clear exempt and secure from all manner of claims whatsoever unto him the said William Pope his Heirs and assigns against all and every Person or persons now and will for ever warrant and defend in witness whereof the said Samuel Francis have hereunto set his hand and seals on the day and Year above written
