

the said Robert Murrell & his heirs and to the said Lane and Negroes and every part thereof with the appurtenances, To have and to hold the said Negroes with their increase also the said Tract of Land and all and singular the premises hereby granted bargained and sold or intended to be hereby bargained and sold and every part thereof with all and every of their appurtenances to him the said Lewis Thorpe his heirs and assigns to the only proper use of him the said Lewis Thorpe his heirs and assigns forever Provided nevertheless and it is agreed by the parties to these presents that if the said Robert Murrell his heirs Executors or administrators shall faithfully pay or cause to be paid unto the said Lewis Thorpe his heirs or assigns the full sum of one hundred and fifty pounds, in the following manner, fifty pounds on or before second day of April next and the remaining one hundred pounds at two equal annual payments with Interest without any abatement or deduction whatever that then and from thenceforth these presents & all contained herein shall cease and be void, any thing to the contrary notwithstanding, and the premises & Negroes to be reconveyed by the said Lewis Thorpe his heirs or assigns to the said Robert Murrell his heirs or assigns.
