one Thousand Seven hundred and Ninety Eight between Henry Taylor
of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia
of the one part & Wynns & Kelly of the said County & State of the other part
Witnesseth that he the said Henry Taylor & Rebekah his wife for &
in consideration of the sum of Eighty Six pounds Current Money
of Virginia To them in hand paid by the said Wynns & Kelly the receipt
whereof the said Henry Taylor & Rebekah his wife doth hereby
acknowledge, have granted, bargained, sold aliened and confirmed by
these presents with grant bargain sell alien & confirm unto the said
Wynns & Kelly their heirs & assigns forever One Acre of Land lying
& being in Southampton County & State aforesaid the same same
being opposite Ellis & Blakes Taverns say the Acre of Land that Wynns
& Kelly now holds under a lease To have & To hold the said Acre
of Land to together with all the appurtenances thereunto be-
longing, or any ways thereunto appurtenant together with
all its franchises to the only further use & behoof of
them the said Wynns & Kelly their heirs and assigns
forever Free from the title claim or hindrance of
Incumbrance of the said Henry Taylor & Rebekah
his wife their heirs & assigns or any other person
or persons claiming the same by from a under
these the said Henry Taylor & Rebekah his wife
for themselves their heirs doth further promise
& agree to & with the said Wynns & Kelly their
heirs and assigns that the rights and title of
the said Land & premises and every part thereof
against all and every person or persons they will
forever warrant and Defend by these presents
forever In Witness whereof the said Henry
Taylor & Rebekah his wife have hereunto set
their hands & seals the one year above written
