sale the 22^d day of October One Thousand seven hundred & Ninety Eight
conveyed unto Charles Bailey of the County of Southampton the sume
staile of and in three hundred & three & one half Acres of Land, with the appur-
tenances lying and being in the County aforesaid, and whereas the said Martha
Herring cannot conveniently travel to the Court of our said County of Southampton
to acknowledge the same; therefore we do give you power to receive the acknowledgment
which the said Martha Herring shall be willing to make before you
of the Conveyance aforesaid contained in the said Indenture which is herin-
 annexed And we do herefore command you to go personally to the said Martha
Herring and examine her privately & apart from her T^o Husband and
receive the acknowledgement which she shall be willing to make before you
& whether she hath executed the said deed freely & voluntarily without the
persuasion or threats of her husband, and whether she is willing the said
Indenture should be recorded in the Court of our said County of South-
ampton, and when you have examined her as aforesaid & taken her acknow-
ledgment of the said Indenture, that you distinctly & openly certify us there-
under your hands & seals, retaining to us also this Thirtieth instant Samuel
