 Me. That I Sarah Vick of the County of Southampton for divers good
 Causes me thereto moving but more especially for the Good will & affection
 that I have for and bear to my son Parks Vick and my Daughter
 Rebecca Gregory, Have given granted and confirmed and by these presents
 do give grant and confirm unto the said Parks Vick and Rebecca Gregory
 and their heirs assigns forever All the Estate of what nature or kind soever
 (Lands only and alone foreseized & excepted) that belongs or in any wise ap-
 pertaining to me from the will of my late husband James Vick and also
 all the estate that I have acquired since the death of my said husband and
 otherwise disposed off or conveyed - To have and to hold the said granted
 Estate unto them the said Parks Vick & Rebecca Gregory & to their heirs
 & assigns forever to the only proper use & behoof of them the said Parks
 Vick & Rebecca Gregory their heirs & assigns forever, and the said Sarah
 Vick for herself her heirs & assigns the said granted estate against her
 the said Sarah Vick or against any person claiming the same from by
 or under her shall & will warrant & forever defend by these presents
 In Witness Whereof the said Sarah Vick hath hereunto set her hand and affixed
 her seal this 25th day of May Anno domini 1799 Now —

This Indenture made this 15th day of December in
 the Year of our Lord one Thousand seven hundred and ninety two Between
 Thomas Sharp of State of N. Carolina of the one part & Robert Merrill of
 State of Virginia Southampton County of the other part Witnesseth that
 the said Thomas Sharp for and in consideration of the sum of Forty five
 pounds Current Money of Virginia in hand paid by the said Robert Merrill
 to the said Thomas before the writing & delivery of these presents the receipt
 whereof the said Thomas Sharp doth hereby acknowledge with
