

This Indenture made this first day of May  
 one thousand seven hundred and ninety nine Between  
 Nathaniel Edwards and Mary his wife of St.ampton  
 County and State of Virginia of the one part and  
 Edmund Turner of the county and State aforesaid  
 of the other part witnesseth that the said Nathaniel  
 Edwards and Mary his wife for & considerations of the sum of One  
 Dollar to him in hand paid by the said Edmund Turner the receipt  
 whereof is hereby acknowledged hath bargained & sold & by these presents  
 do bargain, & sell unto Edmund Turner his heirs and assigns forever  
 a certain Tract or parcel of Land lying in the County of Southampton  
 and Parish of St. Lukes containing by estimation Two hun-  
 dred and fifty Acres, being the same more or less & bounded as follows  
 (To wit,) Beginning in a marsh in the County line thence 98 poles  
 to a pine in a corner of Henry Caffors line thence S. E. E. East 803 pole  
 to a pine in James Wilkinsons line, thence along the S. E. line N<sup>o</sup>. S.  
 164 poles to a sweet Gum in a Branch a corner of Edmund Turners  
 line thence along a line of Marshy Trees of solid Turners, to a con-  
 Gum S. E. 45 W<sup>o</sup>. 36 poles to a Willow Oak S. E. 10 W<sup>o</sup>. 66 poles to an  
 Oak S. E. by E. 68 poles to a Hickory S. E. 50 W<sup>o</sup>. 50 poles and  
 back on the edge of the low grounds, thence down the swash dividing  
 Nathaniel Edwards & Mrs. Martha Turner to the County line  
 thence down the County line to the beginning, being the whole of the  
 land owned by the said Edwards in the County of Southampton  
 To have & to hold the said land & premises with all the appur-  
 tenances &c unto the said Edmund Turner his heirs or assigns  
 forever, and the said Nathaniel Edwards and Mary his wife, their  
 heirs &c, with all & singulars the appurtenances before mentioned  
 unto the said Edmund Turner free from the claim, or claims, of  
 them the said Nathaniel Edwards & Mary his wife their heirs &c  
 and of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall with ~~\$100~~  
 Warrant and to forever defend by these presents (In writing)  
 whereof we the said Nathaniel Edwards & Mary his wife have  
 hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals the day & year  
 first above written
