This Indenture made this eleventh day of January
in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred &
ninety nine. Between Josiah Vick and Elizabeth his wife
of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia of the one part, and John
Pledge of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that the
said Josiah Vick & Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the
sum of Six hundred & sixty ^{two} thirds Spanish milled Silver dollars
to them in hand paid by the said John Pledge at & before his signing
sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Josiah
Vick & Elizabeth his wife doth hereby acknowledge & themselves there-
with fully satisfied contented & paid have bargained sold aliened con-
firmed & confirmed & by these presents doth hereby bargain sell alien confirm
and forever confirm unto the said John Pledge his heirs & assigns a certain
tract plantation or parcel of Land lying & being situated in the said County
of Southampton & parish of Wittingway lying West side of Albrighton Jones
Mill Pond called & known by the name of the Mill Neck & bounded as follows
(to wit) Beginning at the Mouth of a large branch where it enters itself into
the said Albrighton Jones Mill Pond not far above the Mill house
thence binding on the run of said branch a dividing line of seven
feet & the said Josiah Vick ascends to a swamp to William Murphers
line thence Murphers line to Albrighton Jones Mill Pond thence down
the said Mill Pond to the first Station containing by Estimation
one hundred acres be the same more or less (and is a part of the land given
to the said Josiah Vick by his Father Richard Vick senr. by his last Will &
Testament) together with all houses, out houses, Orchards, ways, waters
and water Courses, Mines & Minerals & all other the profits & Commodities
thereof belonging or in any wise appertaining; saving the natural Right
of Sarah But the free & uninterrupted possession of herself to the place
framed House, dairy & new loghouse standing on the said plantation &
such ground & appertinances lying around the said houses as now are under
fence & set apart for her use during the time aforesaid & the free liberty to
her of cutting & selling firewood & lightwood & Alder Timber during the
said time and also saving to the said Josiah Vick his heirs & assigns
the full use & possession of the said lake & premises during the
term of years to have & to hold the said bargained premises with
every of the appertinances unto the said John Pledge his heirs & assigns
forever, to the only proper use & behoof of the said John Pledge his
heirs & assigns forever, except as is here excepted) with the reservation
of the remainder & remainances unto Josiah & his heirs
