

 in the year of our Lord Christ, One Thousand seven hundred & Ninety
 nine Between Josiah Vick & Elizabeth his wife of the County of South
 ampton & State of Virginia of the one part and Benjamin Johnston of the
 same County & State of the other part Witnesseth that the said Josiah
 Vick & Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the sum of eight
 hundred & thirty three Spanish Milled Silver dollars being
 in hand paid by the said Benjamin Johnston at and before the signing
 sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Josiah
 Vick & Elizabeth his wife doth hereby acknowledge themselves there-
 fully satisfied that the bargain, sale and con-
 veyance hereof made by these presents doth truly bargain
 sell, alien, assign & convey unto the said Benjamin
 Johnston his heirs & assigns a certain tract or parcel
 of land lying & situate in the said County of Southampton
 between of Wierway on Fogay in Swamp adjoining the
 lands of William Clarke John Washington William Barnes
 & William Coulter being the same tract of land that the
 said Josiah Vick purchased of William Jones (de.) and
 the estimation two hundred acres by the same man or
