

This Indenture made this eleventh day of January in
 the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and
 ninety nine Between Josiah Vick and Elizabeth his
 wife of the county of Southampton State of Virginia of the one
 part and William Woodard of the same county State aforesaid
 of the other part Witnesses that the said Josiah Vick
 & Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the sum of seven
 hundred & thirty three some three Spanish milled Silver
 dollars to them in hand paid by the said William Woodard
 before the signing sealing & delivery of these presents, the re-
 ceipt whereof the said Josiah Vick & Elizabeth his wife duly
 acknowledge & themselves therewith fully satisfied Con-
 tented should have bargained sold, aliened, enfeoffed and confirmed
 by these presents doth hereby bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff. and
 confirm unto the said William Woodard his heirs and af-
 signs a certain tract piece or parcel of land lying being
 situate in the said County of Southampton State of Virgi-
 nia in Norway parish on the north side of Norway
 River adjoining of the said Josiah Vick & the said
 William Woodard & Simons Vick Shown as follows
 to wit) Beginning at a black gum a corner tree standing on
 the by pass road in the Hog slash in the said parish
 Vick land thence binding on the Cypress Road to a white
 oak on the road near the water hill, thence still
 binding on the said Anna Island side to a Sycamore
 stump or red oak standing in a bottom at the mouth of
 Island fields or wheat patch path thence a straight line to
 be drawn to the corner of the high Ash thence a westerly corner
 a line of marked trees to be made by the said Josiah Vick
 the said William Woodard & Simons Vick to the water
 fields or wheat patch path thence binding on the
 high ground of the said Island fields round to the
 creek thence the said creek to Norway River at the
 three Sycamores bridge, thence up the said river to
 a Holly standing on the river bank a corner tree of
