Holloway and County of Southampton in Virginia of the one part
and William Washington of the Parish and County aforesaid of the other
part Witnesseth that the said Joseph Vick and Feiby his wife for
and in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand and Thirty three Dollars
and Thirty Three Cents Current Money of the state of Virginia to him in
hand paid by the said Joseph Vick at and before the signing sealing &
delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof the said Joseph Vick
doth hereby acknowledge and himself therewith fully satisfied, contented
and quieted bargain, sold, aliened, enfeoffed & confirmed and by
these presents doth hereby bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff and confirm unto
the said William Washington his heirs and assigns, a certain Tract or
parcel of Land lying and being situate in the parish and County
aforesaid beginning at a short gum standing in Holloway swamp
from thence a line of Marked Trees to a pine a corner Tree from thence
along a line of Marked Trees to a flying a corner Tree a dividing line between
Shn. Williams and the said Tract of Land from thence a line of Marked
Trees to a pine standing in the run of a small branch a dividing
line between Matthew Johnson's line and the said Tract of
Land Thence down the run of the said branch to a black gum
from thence by a line of Marked Trees to a black gum standing
on the run of Holloway swamp a corner tree from thence up the
the run of the said swamp to the beginning containing by estimate
thence eighty acres more or less — Together with all
