

This Indenture made this ninth day of February in the  
 year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety nine. Between  
 Danyoy Joyner & Selah his wife & Matthew Bulls & Patsy his wife  
 of the Parish of Mettenay & County of Southampton of the one part and  
 William Rayford of the parish and County aforesaid of the other part  
 Witnesseth that the said Danyoy Joyner & Selah his wife and  
 Matthew Bulls & Patsy his wife for and in consideration of the  
 just & full sum of Eighty five pounds Current money of Virginia by  
 the said William Rayford to them in hand paid at or before the ensing  
 & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Danyoy Joyner  
 & Selah his wife and Matthew Bulls & Patsy his wife doth hereby  
 acknowledge & thereof acquit and discharge the said William Rayford  
 his heirs & assigns forever and doth hereby acknowledge themselves these  
 with to be fully and entirely satisfyed contented and paid they the s.  
 Danyoy Joyner & Selah his wife and Matthew Bulls & Patsy his  
 wife have granted bargained sold set over & delivered and with by these  
 presents grant bargains alien enfeoff release and confirm unto the s.  
 William Rayford who to his heirs & assigns forever all those two Tracts &  
 parcels land that the said Danyoy Joyner & Matthew Bulls now lives  
 on containing by estimation two hundred acres be the same more or  
 less and bounded as follows (townt.) begining at a dog wood standing on  
 the side of the rough branch in Joseph Scott's line thence along a line  
 of marsh to a Maple in the horse bone branch thence down the  
 run of marsh back to the dividing line of new chof? Town between  
 Elasha Joyner & the aforementioned tracts in the board gut thence down  
 the board gut to the main block water river thence down the said river  
 to the end of the rough branch thence up the run of the rough  
 to the dog wood begining the first station being the same land  
 that Joshua Joyner did late of this County gave to his son Danyoy  
 Joyner & Nelson Joyner by his last will duly recorded in the  
 County Court of Southampton with all houses and houses orchard  
 buildings woods water & water courses pastures meadows heredita-  
 ments & appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise affec-  
 taining and the remainder & remains rents & issues & profits  
 thereof and all the estate right title & interest of them the said  
 Danyoy Joyner & Selah his wife and Matthew Bulls & Patsy his  
 wife giving to her same or any part or parcel thereof to have  
 unto to hold the said bargained premises with all & every the
