released set over delivered and confirmed and by these presents doth
grant bargain sell alien enfeoff release set over deliver and confirm
unto the said John Bunley & to his heirs and assigns forever all
that plantation messuage tract and parcel of Land situate lying &
being in the County of Southampton afores^d Containing by appra-
tion One hundred Acres, and being the Lands which the said Jesse
Johnson sold to the said John Bunley by act of indenture bearing
date on or about December One Thousand seven hundred & thirty
seven bounded and described as by the said Deed is expressed and
