Ten less the woods and plantation to the first station bounding by estimation Eighteen 3/4 acres be the same more or less To have hold to hold the said bargain premises with all the appurtenances therunto belonging to him the s<sup>d</sup> Thach. Lawrence his heirs and assigns for ever and they the s<sup>d</sup> Shadrach Cobb and also his wife for themselves their heirs and assigns will warrant and forever defend the said bargain premises against the lawful claim of all & every person whatsoever unto him the said Thach.
