To all to whom these presents shall come Whereas one Henry Pope of the County of Southampton by his certain Indenture of Mortgage bearing date the sixth day of July 1797 did sell and convey unto Jordan Denson a certain Tract of land whereon William Rayford then dwelt under the description of all the lands which Henry Pope father of the aforesaid Henry purchased of John Johnson situate lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid containing by estimation six hundred and twenty acres for the consideration and securing the payment of Three hundred pounds with interest then justly due to the said Jordan Denson and whereas the said Henry Pope hath paid or satisfied part of an acceptance of John Underwood amount of Two hundred & sixty pounds in part of the aforesaid debt now known that I the said Jordan Denson for the consideration aforesaid have and by these presents do remise release & forever quit claim unto the aforesaid Henry Pope and to his heirs and assigns all the right title interest claim or demand of him the said Jordan Denson his heirs and assigns to that part of the said lands which the Henry Pope sold as follows (To wit) beginning at a Coppice in Brannes's line in the former branch thence down to Underwood's line to Mottoway does to a Boundary thence the measure of the said River to a Maple thence north westerly to the beginning - Witness my hand & seal this fifteenth day of July 1799
