Joseph Phillips of Southampton County in Virginia being
fully persuaded that freedom is the natural right of all Man kind
and that it is my duty to do unto others as I would desire to be done by
in the like situation and having under my care one Negro whom I have
heretofore held as a slave by the name of Peter aged about thirty Eight
years I hereby emancipate at set free the said slave and I do for myself
my heirs Executors and administrators relinquish all my my right title
Interest and Claim or pretensions of Claim whatsoever either to his
person or to any Estate he may hereafter acquire the above said Negro
to enjoy his full freedom without any Interruption from me or any
Person claiming for by from or under me. In witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and seal this Nineteenth day of the first
Month in the year of our Lord one Thousand seven hundred and ninety

of our Lord Christ one Thousand seven hundred and ninety Eight Between
Robert Wills & Nancy his wife of the County of Southampton and Parish of
Wottonway of the one part and Joseph W. Moore of the same Parish and County
of the other part Witnesseth that the said Robert Wills & Nancy his wife
for and in consideration of the just and full sum of Two hundred and thirty
one pounds current money of Virginia by the said Joseph Moore to them in
hand paid before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
of the said Robert Wills & Nancy his wife doth hereby acknowledge and
thereof acquit and discharge the said Joseph Moore his heirs and assigns
forever and themselves herewith fully and entirely satisfied Contented
and praise they the said Robert Wills & Nancy his wife hath granted
Bargained sold aliened enfeoffed released set over altered and confirmed
by these presents doth grant bargain sold alien enfeoff released set over altered
and confirmed unto the said Joseph Moore and to his heirs and assigns
forever all that Plantation Messuage Tract and parcel of Land situate
in Robert Wills now lies situate lying & being in the County
