

This Indenture of three parts made this eleventh day of

January in the year of our Lord Christ One thousand seven hundred
 ninety nine Between William Woodward of the County of Southampton
 & State of Virginia of the one part, and Josiah Vick of the same County
 & State aforesaid of another part, and Albrigton Jones and William Blom
 of the same County & State aforesaid of the third part, Witnesses that
 whereas the said William Woodward stands indebted unto the said Josiah
 Vick by writing obligatory, sealed with his seal & dated the day & year
 above mentioned, in the just & full sum of Six hundred & fifty six
 two thirds Spanish Milled silver dollars with lawful interest thereon
 for one half of the above mentioned sum, from the twenty fifth day of
 December next ensuing the date hereof (the time that the said one half
 becomes due & payable); and for the other half or residue of the above
 mentioned sum of Six hundred and sixty six two thirds Spanish Milled
 Dollars from the twenty fifth day of December which shall be in the year
 One thousand eight hundred (the time the same becomes due) & here-
 after after the rate of six per centum per annum from the time the
 said money becomes due & payable, and whereas the said William
 Woodward is desirous that the said debt & interest shall be punctually paid
 & discharged to the said Josiah Vick his heirs Executors administrators
 or assigns on the time the same shall become due according to the
 tenor & effect of the said Writing obligatory before mentioned without
 troubling the said Josiah Vick his heirs Executors administrators or assigns
 in the trouble & expense of prosecuting a suit or suits at Common Law
 or in Chancery to recover the same - Now this Indenture Witnesseth
 that the said William Woodward for & in consideration of the above men-
 tioned premises as for & in consideration of the sum of six shillings current money
 of Virginia, to him in hand paid by the said Albrigton Jones and
 William Blom, at & before the signing sealing and delivery of these
 presents, the receipt whereof the said William Woodward as the party
 acknowledging & thereof acquiescent & discharges the said Albrigton Jones
 William Blom their heirs Executors & administrators forever - having
 first bargained & sold, & by these presents doth hereby grant bargain, sell
 assign & forever confirm unto the said Albrigton Jones & William Blom
 their heirs & assigns a certain tract piece or parcel of land lying
 in the said County of Southampton & parish of Mattanomy within the
 Virginia on the North side of Mattanomy River containing by sur-
 vey one hundred & fifty acres be the same more or less and bounded
 as follows to wit Beginning at black gum a corner tree standing near
 the first said side in the hog slash thence bounding on the said said corner
 towards the third by the bridge to a red oak a corner tree standing
