

her wife have by their certaine Indenture of bargain and sale, the third day of December 1799 conveyed unto her selfe Benjamin Bruey of the County of Southampton the fee Simple estate of land in one hundred and fifty five acres of land be the same more or less and where as her selfe cannot conveniently travel to the Court of our said County to whom justice is the same therefore we do give to you power to execute the whole Indenture which she said Lucy shall be willing to make before you a conveyance aforesaid contained in the said Indenture which is here annexed unto we do therefore command you to go personally to the said Lucy and examine her privately and apart from her husband (in whose knowledge of the same) whether she hath renounced the said Decree freely and voluntarily without the persuasion of her husband, and whether she is willing the said Indenture should be recorded in Court of our said County of Southampton? and when you have examined her as aforesaid and taken her acknowledgement of the same that you distinctly and openly certifye thereto under your hands in sets returning to us also this writ with the said Indenture annexed witness Sam' Kello Clerk of our said Court at his office the 1st day of Decr 1799 - and in 2d year of the Commonwealth
