in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety
between Daniel Boykin and Nancy his wife of the County of Southam-
pton of the one part and Joshua Noble of the County of the aforesaid of the
other part Witnesseth that the said Daniel Boykin and Nancy his
wife for and in consideration of the sum of Twelve pounds fifteen
shillings lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said
Noble before the signing and delivery of these presents the receipt
whereof they the said Daniel Boykin and Nancy his wife do hereby
acknowledge through every part & parcel thereof both fully clearly &
absolutely agree to remittre & discharge the said Joshua Noble his
Debtors about by these presents and for diverse good causes & considerations
them touching touching they the said Daniel Boykin and Nancy his
wife have granted bargained and sold aliened conveyed & confirmed by these
presents for themselves their heirs & successors as grant & conveyance
sell alien assign and convey unto Joshua Noble his heirs and
assigns forever one certain Tract or Parcel of Land containing Twenty
five & a half acres more or less being part of a Tract or parcel of Land
belonging to the said Daniel Boykin by his Father & now in his
possession beginning at a black Oak Spring on the south side of a
water Swamp in the County of Southampton aforesaid and
Charles Knight's line thence up the S. line of S. Knight's
