This Indenture made this Twentieth day of January in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Eight hundred between John and Catharine Mitchell his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Christian Whitehead of the County of Southampton & State of the other part Witnesseth that the S^d John and Catharine Mitchell his wife do acknowledge and own themselves fully satisfied and content therewith for the sum of Fifteen Pounds Three Shillings Current Money of Virginia to them in hand paid and thereupon have given granted, bargained, sold, Alien, conveyed and confirmed and by these presents do give grant bargain sell alien convey and confirm unto the S^d Christian Whitehead her heirs and assigns forever one certain Tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County aforesaid containing by estimation Thirty acres and one sixth part of an acre be the same more or less it being the one sixth part of S^d Christian Whitehead's former in her de^d Husband William Mitchell Lands and bounded as by the report of the Commissioners appointed by the Court of Southampton for the purpose of dividing the Lands of said de^d
