privily examined as the Law directs, and ordered to be recorded

This Indenture made this day of in the year
of our Lord eighteen hundred. Between Clarissa Whitehead of the one
part, John Whitehead of the second part, and Lazarus Cook of the third part
each of the County of Southampton, Witnesseth, that whereas the sd Clarissa
Whitehead stands justly indebted to the said John Whitehead by a writing
obligatory under her hand & seal bearing equal date with these presents in
the sum of three hundred and thirty five pounds 12/4/3p as the writing
obligatory expresses, and whereas for the further assurance & securing the
payment aforesaid, it is agreed by the sd Clarissa Whitehead & John Whitehead that
a conveyance interest shall be made to the sd Lazarus Cook for the benefit
of the sd John Whitehead in case the sd writing obligatory should not be punctually
discharged when due. Now This Indenture therefore Witnesseth
that the sd Clarissa Whitehead for & in consideration of the premises aforesaid
& for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar to have
herein paid to her by the said John Whitehead as hereby acknowledged - Both the said
bargain sold & released & confirmed by these presents doth for
herself her heirs & assigns & administrators grant bargain sell alien
make over & confirm unto the sd John Whitehead - and to his heirs &
administrators & assigns, two tracts or parcels of Land situate lying &
being in the County of Southampton, one Tract known by the name
of the donors land of the sd Clarissa Whitehead which formerly
belonged to William Whitehead dec'd referred to the Commissioners report
who were appointed to lay of the sd donors land, will fully appear, the other
tract being the land of sd Whitehead dec'd which was allotted to John Whitehead
& Catharine his wife by the aforesd Commissioners, reference to the report
and will also fully appear, which land has been sold and conveyed by the
sd John Whitehead to the aforesaid Clarissa; In Trust nevertheless
and upon this express condition, that if the sd Clarissa Whitehead her
heirs Executors & Administrators shall punctually pay or cause to be
paid to the sd John Whitehead his heirs and assigns the aforesd sum
