 Carolina the one part and Andrew Hoodley of Blount County in the  
 state of North Carolina the other part Witnesseth that s<sup>d</sup> Willis Hoodley for  
 the sum of four hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by the s<sup>d</sup> Andrew  
 Hoodley the receipt whereof I hereby acknowledge have bargained sold  
 and conveyed unto Andrew Hoodley one certain tract of land situate in the  
 County of Southampton in the state of Virginia near Southampton Church  
 in the fork of the road containing by Estimation Ten Acres be it the  
 same more or less it being the land s<sup>d</sup> Hoodley bought of William Fran-  
 cis Bidwell bounded agreeable to the original Deed, which reference  
 may be had most fully together with all woods uninclosed houses outhouses  
 fences and privileges with all the premises thereto belonging or in-  
 any wise appertaining containing by estimation Ten Acres
