



And the S^d John Wright & Sarah his wife doth for themselves their heirs Covenants & agree with the said Mary & William Jarrell their heirs & assigns that the said John Wright & Sarah his wife their heirs executors and administrators shall & will warrant and forever defend the above mentioned Land & premises unto the said Mary & William Jarrell their heirs & assigns forever against the claim or title of all persons or persons whatsoever.
