consideration of one hundred pounds of lawful Money of this Commonwealth
to them in hand paid by the S^d Benjamin Blunt Es^r at or before the execu-
tion and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
have bargained & sold and by these presents do vend of them with law-
ful and solemn title the S^d Benjamin Blunt Es^r his heirs & assigns
