This Indenture made this Twenty seventh day of December
 in the year one thousand seven hundred and Ninety Nine. Between Samuel
 Dredy & Lucy his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and
 Miles Cary of the same County of the Other part Witnesseth that the sd. Samuel
 Dredy & Lucy his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Four hundred
 and twenty four Pounds to them in hand paid by the sd. Miles Cary at or before
 the sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 Have granted sold assigned & sold aliened release and Confirmation and by these
 presents do grant bargain and sell aliened release and Confirmation to the
 sd. Miles Cary his heirs and assigns a certain plantation tract or parcel
 of Land situate lying and being in the parish of St. Luke & County of South
 ampton aforesaid and on the south side of Rotterdam river containing
 three Acres and twelve Decies be the same more or less and bounded as
 follows to wit: Beginning at a white Oak a corner between a long
 a marked line to the head of a branch (where John Simmons made beech)
 thence down the sd. branch to the Offspring branch then down the Offspring
 branch to Rotterdam River thence up the river to the Spring branch then
 up the longness of the river to a large poplar a corner of Henry Simmons
 and thence a straight line of marked trees up the steep bottom to the
 beginning which comprehends all the lands bought by the sd. Samuel
 & Mary Simmons and also the reversion and reversions remainders and
 several other rights & services therof and of every part therof with all
 and singulars & writings touching or any ways concerning the same. I do
 hereby to hold the sd. plantation tract & parcel of Land with
