Amelia his Wife for and in consideration of the Sum of Five hundred
Pounds current Money of Virginia to them in hand paid the S^r Rob^t
whereof the S^r Baris Nicholson and Amelia his Wife doth hereby
acknowledge hath granted Bargained and sold and doth by these presents
grant Bargain and sell unto Robert Nicholson of Southampton his
heirs and assigns forever a certain parcel or tract of Land lying
and being in the County of Southampton and South side of
Nottingham River Containing by estimation Three hundred and
Ten acres be it more or be it less and bounded as followeth, Beginning
at a Decimon on the Run of the Raccoon swamp, a corner of Thomas
Gilliams Land thence along his line to a black jack a corner of
Charles Barham's Land thence along a line of marked trees to a
white Oak a corner in Benjamin Bulle's Land thence along his
line to a Cypress on the run of the racoon Swamp opposite to
thence up the Run of the said swamp to beginning the Land
