tone 2 Killing Hoes 3 Weeding Ditto 4 Axes 3 pots & 12 Barrels of
corn To have and To Holde the Bargained artickles their Heirs &
assigns to the only use & behoof of the said James Johnson William Brister
Matthew Jones & Samuel Baisden their Heirs & assigns forever & the
said Isaac Hedgpeth for myself do covenant and agree to & with the
said James Johnson William Brister Matthew Jones & Samuel Baisden
that I the said Isaac Hedgpeth my Heirs Executors and administrators
and bargaind property unto the said James Johnson William Brister
Matthew Jones & Samuel Baisden their Heirs & assigns I shall and well
warrant and forever defend by these presents In Witness whereof I the
said Isaac Hedgpeth have set my hand seal this 4th Day of December
1799
