 When said Witnesseth, that the S^r Lewis Bryant for & in con-
 sideration of the sum of Ten Dollars, to him in hand paid by
 the said Onor Dardon & his Wife the receipt whereof he
 doth acknowledge himself fully satisfied hath
 sold & delivered, & doth by these presents bargain
 sell & deliver unto the S^r Matthew Bryant, One certain Parcel
 or parcel of Land lying & being in the County afores^d containing
 by estimation Ninety six Acres, be the same more or less and
 bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning at a Lightwood post a
 corner in Charles Brasong line, thence along the S^r Bird-
 line, thence along the S^r Wm^s line to a pine a corner in James
 Bryants (of Lewis) line, thence along the S^r Bryants line to the
 stem of the Stary branch, thence down the stem of S^r Branch
