 of the County of Southampton & state of Virginia of the one part
 Lewis Bryant Sen. of S. County & state of the other part Wit-
 neßeth that the said James Edwards for & in consideration
 of the sum of Fifty Dollars to him in hand paid by the said
 Bryant, the receipt whereof the said James Edwards doth acknow-
 ledge himself fully satisfied hath bargained sold & delivered and
 doth by these presents bargain sell & deliver unto the S. Lewis Bryant
 his heirs & assigns forever, a certain tract or parcel of Land lying &
 being in the County of Southampton containing by Estimation two
 acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows (To-wit)
 Beginning at a white oak (at the water house) a corner in West Plains
