This Indenture made this twentieth day of January
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred Between
Barnaby Drake of the county of Southampton and Parish of
Netorway of the one part and Archibald Drake of the county
& parish aforesaid of the other part Witneseth that the said
Barnaby Drake for and in consideration of the just & full sum
of one hundred & seventy four Dollars & 73 cents current money
of Virginia by the said Archibald Drake to him in hand
paid the receipt whereof the said Barnaby Drake doth hereby
acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge the said Archibald
Drake his heirs & assigns forever and himself therewith fully
& intirely satisfied contented and paid he the said Barnaby
Drake hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed released
set over delivered and confirmed and by these presents doth give
bargain sell alien enfeoff release, set over deliver and confirm
unto the said Archibald Drake and to his heirs and assigns forever
all that messuage Tract and parcel of Land which the said
Barnaby Drake bought of John Oberly by Indenture bearing
date in or about the year 1779 situate lying and being in
the County of Southampton and Parish of Netorway aforesaid
containing by estimation One hundred Acres be the same more
or less, bounded and described as by the said Oberly Deed is
expressed & declared, and all the houses out houses edifices
buildings, woods, ways, waters, and water courses gardens orchards
profits Commodities hereditaments and appurtenances whosoever
to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining and
the reversion and reversions, remainders and remainderments
rents issues & profits thereof and all the Estate right title
interest claims demand of him the said Barnaby Drake
of or to the same and every part and parcel thereof. If
have and to hold the said plantation Messuage
Tract and parcel of One hundred Acres of Land with
and every the appurtenances as aforesaid unto him the said
Archibald Drake and his heirs & assigns forever to the only proper
use and behoof of him the said Archibald Drake his heirs & assigns
forever and the said Barnaby Drake for himself his heirs
