

This Indenture made this Day of
 one Thousand Seven hundred & ninety Eight between Jordan
 Judkins of the county of Southampton of the one part & Thomas
 Prillow & William Wiguhart of the Same County of the other part
 witnesseth that whereas the Said Thomas Prillow & William Wiguhart
 aforesaid have become Securitys for this said Jordan Judkins to John
 Gualtney of Southampton in the Sum of Five hundred Pounds
 to be paid to the aforesaid John Gualtney & the Said Jordan
 Judkins being willing to Indemnify the Said Thomas Prillow &
 William Wiguhart from any Loss that they may be Subjected to by
 being such Security Now this Indenture witnesseth that the Said
 Jordan Judkins in consideration of the above Securityship as
 well as that of one Dollar to him in hand paid by the Said Tho-
 mas Prillow & William Wiguhart the receipt whereof the Said Jordan
 Judkins doth hereby acknowledge & thereof acquit & discharge
 the Said Thomas Prillow & William Wiguhart Their heirs Admin-
 & Executors for ever hath Bargained & Sold & doth by these pre-
 sents bargain & sell unto the Said Thomas Prillow & William Wiguhart
 their heirs & assigns forever The following Tracts of Land Viz
 that the Said Jordan Judkins now lives on containing Two
 Hundred & Fifty Acres more or Less - the Tract formerly the
 property of James Bailey containing Two Hundred & Seventy
 Acres more or Less & The Tract bought of James Johnson containing
 Two Hundred & Eighty four Acres more or Less, also that he
 of Willis Windham containing Seventy Five Acres more or Less
 To have and to hold the Said land & premises with all the
 the appurtenances thereunto belonging for the purpose of Indemnifying
 the Said Thomas Prillow & William Wiguhart in case of any Loss
 their Engagement as Security for the Said Jordan Judkins
 and the Said Jordan Judkins doth for himself his heirs
