Judkins of the county of Southampton of the one part & Thomas
Pritlow & William Urquhart of the same County of the other part
witnesseth that whereas the Said Thomas Pritlow & William Urquhart
aforesaid have become Security for this said Jordan Judkins to John
Quallney of Southampton in the sum of Five hundred Pounds
to be paid to the aforesaid John Quallney & the Said Jordan
Judkins being willing to Indemnify the Said Thomas Pritlow &
William Urquhart from any loss that they may be Subjected to by
being such Security Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said
Jordan Judkins in consideration of the above Securityship as
well as that of one Dollar to him in hand paid by the Said Thomas
Pritlow & William Urquhart the receipt whereof the said Jordan
Judkins doth hereby acknowledge & thereof aquit & discharge
the Said Thomas Pritlow & William Urquhart their heirs Adm:
& Executors for ever hath Bargained & sold & doth by these pres-
ents bargain & sell unto the Said Thomas Pritlow & William Urquhart
their Heirs & Assigns forever The following Tracts of Land viz
that the Said Jordan Judkins now lives on containing two
Hundred & Fifty Acres more or less - the Tract formerly the
property of James Bailey Containing two Hundred & Sixty
Acres more or less & the Tract bought of James Johnson contain-
ing Two Hundred & Eighty four acres more or less also that tract
of Will's Windham Containing Seventy Five acres more or less
To have and to hold the Said land & premises with all the
appurtenances thereto belonging for the purpose of Andemnifying
the Said Thomas Pritlow & William Urquhart in case of any loss
their Engagement as security for the Said Jordan Judkins
and the Said Jordan Judkins doth for himself his heirs
