affection which I have and do bear towards my loving son
Frederick Boykin of the same parish and county have

and grant unto the said Frederick Boykin his heirs body
or Assigns a couple of negroes by the name Patience and
Phillip for which before the signing of these presents I
have delivered the said Frederick Boykin the said negroes above mentioned
to have and to hold the said negroes in the said premises or to his heirs
Executors or Administrators from henceforth as his proper Right
Absolutely without any manner of Condition In witness whereof
have hereunto set my hand and Seal this Sixth day of February 1799
