that they the said Jesse Bracey and Mary his wife for and in
consideration of the just and full sum of sixty six pounds current
Money of Virginia to him the said Jesse Bracey in hand paid before
the sealing, and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
they the said Jesse Bracey and Mary his Wife doth hereby acknow-
ledge and there of acquit and discharge The said John Plythe
his heirs and assigns forever and themselves Therewith fully
and intirely satisfied contented and paid. they the said Jesse
Bracey and Mary his Wife hath granted bargained sold aliened
enjoyed released set over delivered and confirmed and by these presents
doth grant bargain sell alien enjoin release set over deliver and
confirm unto the said John Plythe and to his heirs and assigns for
ever that plantation mebuage Tract and parcel of Land whereon
Thomas Mountfortt the brother of Wade Mountfortt Junr had in
possession which was withd to the said Wade Mountfortt by his fa-
ther Thomas Mountfortt concluding by Estimation one hundred and thirty
five acres or there abouts more or less situated lying and being in the
County of Southampton and bounded off follows by the old pasture
being the said Land that Jacob Turner (of Ches) and Christian his Wife
sold to the said Thomas Mountfortt and gave it to his son above
mentioned and all the houses out houses edifices buildings woods
ways waters and water courses profits Commodities hereditaments
and appurtenances whatsoever to the said one hundred and thirty five
Acres of land premises belonging, it being the said Land that Jacob
Turner (of Ches) and Christian his wife sold to the said Thomas Mount-
fortt and gave it to his son above mentioned and all the commodities -
hereditaments and appurtenances what soever to the same belonging
or in any wise appertaining and the reversion and reversions Remainder
and Remainders rents issues & in any wise appertaining and the reversion
and Reversions Remainder and Remainders rents Issues and profits
