To all People to whom these presents shall come Henry Jones & Wife Elizabeth Jones do send greeting, know ye that the said Henry Jones & wife Elizabeth Jones of the parish of Rattway in the county of Southampton Whitefield that the said Henry Jones and his Wife Elizabeth Jones for and in consideration of the Love good will and affection which we have and do bear to wards my loving Son James Jones of the same parish and county, have given and granted and by these presents do freely, give and grant unto the said James Jones his heirs Executors and administrators forever, one tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the aforesaid county of Southampton on the South side of Black Creek Containing by Estimation one hundred and 25 Acres more or Less and bounded as follows Beginning at a Wickery a corner tree of Joseph Densons and Henry Blackheads from thence along the S^d Densons line of marked trees to the Rode that leads from Black water Bridge to Jerusalem from thence Down the said Rode to a gum a corner Tree of Henry Jones line from thence Southeast along the S^d Jones line of marked trees to a corner Tree of the S^d Jones and a line tree of Elisha Bradshaws from thence North-East along the said line to a pine a marked tree from thence a short line across the peeson to the head of the line Branch to Thomas Jones line from thence Down the said Branch to a pine a corner tree of Henry Blackheads line from thence South-West along the said line to a pine a corner tree of the S^d Blackheads line from thence North-West to the first Station and all houses out houses Gardens Buildings, yards gardens Orchards Woods under Woods trees Waters water Courses profits Commodities hereditaments and appurtenances to the said tract or parcel of Land belonging or in any wise appurtenant to the same and the reversion and reversions thereof and all the estate right title Interest Claims or demand whatsoever of the S^d Henry Jones & Wife Elizabeth Jones of in and to the said tract or parcel of Land and premises with all the appurtenances and all deeds witnesses and writings whatsoever touching or in anywise concerning the same To have and to hold the said land and premises with all the appurtenances unto the S^d James Jones his heirs and
