This Indenture made this tenth day of March
in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand Eight Hundred
between Nathaniel Pope and Mary his wife of the one part
and of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia
and Evans Pope of the said county and state of the other
part witnesseth that the said Nathaniel Pope and Mary his
wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred &
one pounds five shillings Current money of Virginia to him
in hand paid by the said Evans Pope at or before the sealing
and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Nathaniel
Pope and Mary his wife hath bargained sold aliened and
confirmed unto the said Evans Pope his heirs and assigns for
ever a certain Tract or dividend of Land situate lying and
being in the county of Southampton and containing by estimation
sixty acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows (To wit) be-
ginning at a hickory, a corner tree between Amos Joyner dec'd land and
the said land and in John Darnes line thence along Joyner's
line to a pine, a corner tree of said Joyner's land and the said
Nathaniel Pope's land thence along, said Joyner's line to a pine
