This Indenture made this 25 day of 2nd Mo 1800 -
between Mary Portice of Southampton county and state of
Virginia of the one part and William Spiry of the s.d.
County and State of the other part Witnesseth that the s.d.
Mary Portis for and in consideration of the sum of forty nine
Dollars & one fourth to her in hand paid by the said William
Spiry the receipt whereof the said Mary Portice hath grant-
ed bargained and sold alien Enffoff and by these presents doth
grant bargain and sell Alien Enffoff and confirm unto the
said William Spiry his Heirs and Assigns forever one cer-
tain Tract or parcel of Land containing by Estimation fifty
Acres be the same more or less situate lying and being in the
county of Southampton and state of Virginia on the South
Side the Lightwood swamp and bounded as follows Vizt.
Beginning at a corner pine in Allen Delachies line and
thence a long s.d. Wighams line s.
42 w to p thence s 72 w to p a corner wd oak thence s 76 w
35 pole a corner pine thence due north 82 pole a large wd
corner pine, and also all trees Woods underwoods common
commons of Pastures profits commodities advantages Enclosures
and Hereditaments whatsoever to the said tract or parcel of Land
above mentioned belonging as in any wise appertaining, as in
