This Indenture made the seventh day of April One thousand eight hundred Between John Glover Jun^r and Mary his wife of the one part and Joseph Fowler of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Glover Mary his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty five Pounds six shilling current money of Virginia to him in the paid by the said Joseph Fowler the receipt whereof the said John Glover and Mary his wife do hereby confess and acknowledge have granted bargained sold aliened conveyed and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell aliened convey & confirm unto the said Joseph Fowler his heirs & assigns forever a certain parcel of Land and appurtenances lying and being in the county of Southampton and bounded in the following manner Beginning at a water oak on Joshua Gardeners line along said line to a post oak a corner tree of James Gardeners line Joshua Gardeners & Shadrach Snuffer thence James Gardeners line to a red oak thence a straight line to the post Station Containing by estimation Thirty six acres with all the appurtenances issues and profits and all the liberties and prevelages thereunto belonging and any and every appurtenances and the reversion & remainder hereinafter & remaining of all and singular the
