This Indenture made this twenty first day of
April one thousand Eight hundred Between John Williams
and Mary his wife of the county of Southampton and state
of Virginia of the one part and Nathan Porter of the same
county and state of the other part Witnesseth that the said
John Williams and Mary his wife for and in consideration of
the sum of one hundred and ninety pounds current money of
the state of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said
Nathan Porter at or before the signing sealing and delivering
of these presents the receipt whereof the said John Williams &
Mary his wife doth hereby acknowledge and themselves therewith
fully satisfy contented and paid having bargained and sold
and by these presents doth hereby bargain sell alien assign
and forever confirm unto the said Nathan Porter his heirs and
assigns a certain plantation tract or parcel of land lying
and being and situate in the county of Southampton and
state of Virginia aforesaid and bounded as follows (To wit)
Beginning at a red oak a corner tree of Benjamin Williams
line decd and Jacob Barnes line thence a straight line of
marked trees to a branch thence leaving the branch following
S^r Williams' line to Motoway Swamp thence down the run
of the S^r Swamp to a black gum standing on the south side
of the said swamp thence a south course a line of marked
trees to a pine a corner tree in William Washingtons line
thence a south east course to a Hickory a corner tree in
J^r Johnsons line thence a west course a line of marked trees
to Jacob Barnes line thence the said Barnes line to
the beginning containing by estimation so Seventy two rods
more or less the same as left together with all the
ways waters & water courses mines minerals profits and
