This Indenture made this seventeenth day of June in
the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety, nine
between Robert Maby, Sheriff, and administrator with the will annexed
of James Porch dec^d of the county of Southampton of the one part
and Hannah Westbrook of the said county of the other part—
Witnesseth that the said Robert Maby administrator of the
said James Porch dec^d as aforesaid, and in conformity with the will of
his testator (James Porch dec^d) bearing date the third day of May
one thousand seven hundred and Eighty seven which said Will
is duly recorded in the county court of Southampton, hath for
in consideration of the sum of Four hundred and Seventeen Dollars and
forty Cents to him the said Maby administrator as aforesaid, in
hand paid by the said Hannah Westbrook, at and before the con-
-ling and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said
Maby administrator as aforesaid doth hereby acknowledge; granted
bargained, sold, released and confirmed, and by these presents he
grant bargain sell release and confirm unto the said Hannah
Westbrook her heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel
of Land situate lying and being in the aforesaid county of South-
-ampton containing by survey one hundred and four acres
the same more or less and bounded as follows (Viz) Beginning
-ing at a small branch in David Westbrook's line thence up the
said Branch Two hundred and five pole to James Atkinson's line
thence along the said Atkinson's line Eighty nine and a half pole
