Know all Men by these presents that I Ann Darden of Southampton County Virginia for and in consideration of the sum of Nineteen Pounds twelve shilling and eight pence to me in hand paid by Dolly C Hines before the ensuing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge and myself to be therewith fully satisfied and paid have bargained sold and delivered and by these presents do bargain sell and deliver to her the said Dolly C Hines the following property (to wit) Two feather Beds and furniture one Walnut Desk and one Walnut Dining Table to have and to hold the said beds Desk & Table to her the said Dolly C Hines & her heirs forever — And that I Ann Darden for myself my heirs executors & administrators do and will warrant and forever defend the said beds Desk and table against the lawful claim or Demand of
