in the year Eighteen hundred Between Benjamin Blunt
John^{to} Blow — j^r adm^r with the will annexed of Richard Edwards dec^d
Nov. 1804 the one part and John Thomas Blow s^r of the other part
Deliv^d to Whereas Richard Edwards of the county of Surrey, by his last
Will and Testament among other things directed that his
Ex^{or} Executor should sell all the residue and remainder of his estate
of every kind for certain purposes therein mentioned
and among the residuum is one Lot and parcel of Land in
the county of Southampton devised to him by his brother
Benjamin Edwards and set apart to the said Richard by
Commissioners under a decree of the high court of Chancery in
reference to all which will make the same more fully appear
Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said Benjamin
Blunt adm^r &c with the will annexed of Richard Edwards
dec^d for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty pounds
current money of Virginia to him in hand paid at or before
the sealing and delivery of these presents by the said John
Thomas Blow s^r the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
hath granted bargain and sold aliened released & confirmed
and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell alien
release & confirm unto the said John Thomas Blow s^r a
certain lot parcel & tract of Land situate lying and being
on the South side of Yellowway river in the county of
said near the town of Jerusalem and is the lot
