and Nathan Pope of the same county & state aforesaid of
the other part Witnesseth that the said William Woodard
& Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the sum of
Twenty pounds current money of the said state of Virginia
to them in hand paid by the said Nathan Pope at and
before the signing sealing and delivery of these presents the
receipt whereof the said William Woodard & Elizabeth
his wife doth hereby acknowledge and themselves thereunto
fully satisfy^d contented & paid have bargained sold alien
enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth hereby
bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said
Nathan Pope his heirs and assigns a Certain piece tract
or parcel of Land lying and being situate in the said county
of Southampton and parish of Salloway adjoining the
Lands of John Browe Josiah Wick John Pledger & William
Woodard party to these presents— Bounded as follows
Beginning at a small red oak sapling in the said parish
Wicks line standing on the side of the hog slash there
the 36th E forty two pole down the said slash thence and
