said Josiah Vick & Eliz^a his Wife for and in consid-
eration of the sum of six hundred & sixty pounds — Current
money of this said State of Virginia to them in hand
paid by the said William Woodard at and before the sign-
ing sealing & delivery of these presents the of which said
sum the said Josiah Vick & Elizabeth his wife doth here
by acknowledge and themselves therewith fully satisfy.
Contented & paid have bargained sold aliened enfeoffed &
confirmed and by these presents doth hereby bargain sell
alien enfeoff & forever confirm unto the said William Wood-
ard his heirs and assigns a certain plantation tract or
parcel of land lying and being situate in the parish of Net-
toway and County of Southampton on the North side of
Nettoway River bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning
at a white oak a corner tree of this tract of W^m Bourcier
in W^m Barnes line thence binding on said Barnes line
to a white oak a new made corner tree as to this tract still on
said Barnes line thence binding on line of new marked
trees to a scrub oak sapling standing in the fork of South
key & black water roads thence a course to be run in such
directions as shall leave to the said Josiah Vick out of his
whole tract between this line & the lines of John Rowe &
W^m Barnes fifty acres of Land which & fifty acres of
Land to be set apart and retained as aforesaid is not
