Barnes & Rebecca his wife of the parish of St. Luke & county
of Southampton of the one part & Arthur Foster of the same
parish & county of the other part Witnesseth that the said Wm
Barnes & Rebecca his wife for and in consideration of the sum
of fifteen pounds seventeen shillings & sixpence to them in
hand paid by the said Arthur Foster the receipt whereof they
do hereby acknowledge Have granted bargained & sold and by
these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Arthur
Foster and to his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or
Parcel of Land lying and being in the county aforesaid
on the north side of Buckhorn swamp joining
the said Arthur Foster's line containing Eighteen & half acres
